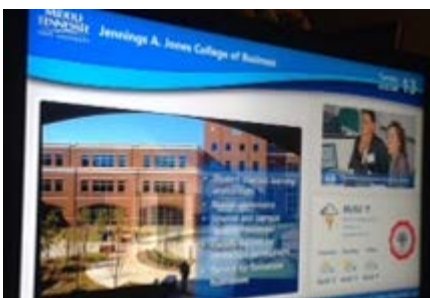


### FSA Domain Migration
