Outlook Tips

Do you know you can quickly create a calendar entry from an email?

Just drag and drop the email on the calendar icon in the bottom left corner of the Outlook program.



A New Appointment window will open for you to complete the details of the new calendar entry. The body of the email will automatically be copied to the appointment notes.

Word Tips

How to capture an application screen to insert in a Word document?

Very easy, go to Insert, under the Illustrations group, select Screenshot. An Available Windows window will open showing all the currently open programs. Just pick the one you want and done!

Excel Tips

Need to graph data in a map?

Use Fill Maps. If you have data in a two-column table, make sure the first column is a state, city, zip code, GPS coordinate or any location related element. Then, highlight the table data, go to Insert, under Charts, click on Maps, select Filled Map. From there you can change the style, colors, etc.

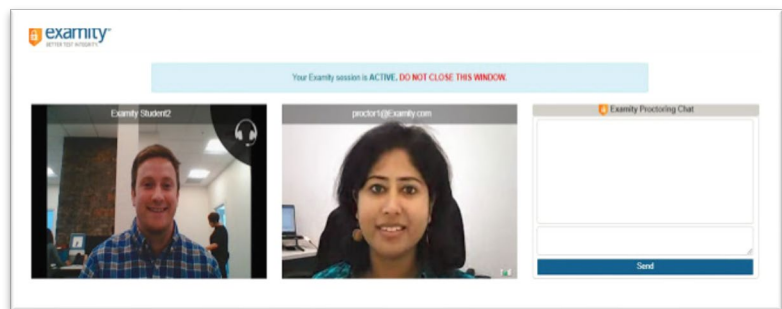
Technology Upgrade in Lab and Master Classrooms
