- **SGA Senate Meetings**
- **Dates: January 26th, February 2nd, 9th, 16th, and 23rd, 2023**
- **University Traffic Committee:**
 - **Date: February 27th, 2023**
 - I represented the SGA and the student body at the first University Traffic Committee meeting of the Spring 2023 semester. The committee saw roughly sixty (60) appeals at this meeting.
- **Parking Appeals:**
 - **Dates: January 16th – February 27th, 2023**
 - Since the beginning of the semester, I have heard seventy-two (72) appeals through my office. Several students selected to be seen at hearing dates throughout the semester and their hearings will be held on those dates.
- **Student Judicial Board (SJB):**
 - At the beginning of the semester one of the justices of the SJB tendered her resignation to me by email. I pulled applications from the Fall and offered interviews to two students after they cleared conduct checks by the Office of Student conduct. After a successful interview, I offered the vacant seat to a new member on Jan. 30th. The new member received training on traffic court policy and procedures on Feb. 13th.
 - The board's first traffic court hearing of the semester was held on Feb. 17th where they heard appeals by students on traffic citations they had received this semester.
 - I have one justice on the board that is interested in fixing some of the issues students discuss during their hearings. He has met with the Vice President of the SGA regarding possibly writing a petition and has even met with Assistant Vice President, Ron Malone, regarding the student's concerns.
- **Parking Awareness Event:**
 - **Date: April 3rd, 2023**
 - I have planned a parking awareness event for the student body. The event will serve as an open forum and workshop for students to voice their concerns about parking and how it is handled on campus.
