RESOLUTION TO INCREASE THE SGA STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE

Sponsored by: House: Jerome Hurska
Senate: Aaron Tallent, Jennifer Sykora,
Brian Gillespie, Tyson McClanahan, Jeremy
Parham

Whereas: Currently, the student activity fee is used to provide entertainment, social, and educational programs at MTSU and supplement student organizations with funds for quality programs.

Whereas: The SGA Student Activity Fee funds are severely limited, and in many cases organizations and program providers have no funding.

Whereas: Last year, less than one-fourth of programs requesting money were funded.

Whereas: Currently, this activity fee funds programs for Student Government, Sports Clubs, and Student Organizations. Limited funding is also provided to supplement program activities, including concerts, lectures, and fine arts programs.

Whereas: A larger SGA Student Activity Fee could produce higher quality programming and entertainment on weeknights and weekends, such as better known entertainers and speakers. In addition, more student organization requests for funding could be granted.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE ENACTED BY THE MAJORITY VOTE OF THE STUDENTS OF MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

Section 1: The SGA Student Activity Fee will be increased from \$5.00 to \$20.00 per person.

Section 2: The SGA Student Activity Fee will be apportioned as follows:

Student Organizations:	\$10
Student Programming:	\$3
Student Government:	\$3
Sports Clubs:	\$2
University Lectures:	\$2

Section 3: This increase shall take effect upon the beginning of the semester after which it is passed by a majority vote on the referendum of the student body.
