Whereas: Increased attendance would make MTSU Athletic events more enjoyable and would create a better atmosphere


Whereas: Most other public universities in Tennessee offer discounted or free admittance to home sporting events.


Section 1: Faculty and Staff shall be given free admittance to all MTSU athletic events
