A Resolution to extend the James E. Walker Library hours

- Whereas:** The James E. Walker Library not only houses books, periodicals and other research material for students, but is also a place for students to study, work on projects and prepare for presentations. The library is a quiet place to study with several options of where to study, such as individual desks, tables, or study rooms.
- Whereas:** The Business and Aerospace Computer Lab is accessible 24/7 but has no designated area for studying or for groups to meet. The BAS computer lab frequently has excessive noise and distraction preventing students from working efficiently, especially students trying to work in groups.
