**Whereas:** Some groups are using the information to send scam emails with links that lead to phishing links designed to steal identities.


**Whereas:** University officials would still have access to student information upon favorable passage.

**Whereas:** Legitimate third parties could still go through the Career Development Center or other necessary departments to access student information.


