A resolution to include vapor usage in all tobacco-free materials presented by Middle Tennessee State University

Whereas: The tobacco-free campaign has been in effect since June 2011, with

implementation taking place in January 2012;

Whereas: Current Middle Tennessee State University documentation refers to products

similar to vapor and electronic cigarettes;

Whereas: The potential dangers of e-cigarettes have been forewarned by the FDA, noting

the use of nicotine;

Whereas: Many students do not care to be around the vapor smoke.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 76^{TH} CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

Section 1: In order to enforce what is not publically stated, Middle Tennessee State

University shall henceforth include the word "vapor" in all tobacco-free materials,

so as to read "tobacco and vapor free".

Section 2: This will take effect immediately upon passage.
