## SGA Resolution 4-14-S

## A resolution to install electronic signs around the campus of Middle Tennessee State University and do away with all yard signs currently on our campus grounds.

Whereas:	Yard signs clutter and lessen the beauty of our campus grounds;
Whereas:	Replacing the often stolen and disappearing yard signs becomes costly to the sponsoring departments;
Whereas:	Advertisers often forget to clean up their yard signs or forget their location;
Whereas:	There is a more efficient and rewarding method of advertisement for our campus, that may bring funding for our future students;
Whereas:	Electronic signs would allow our university a continual source of revenue well into the future.

## THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 76<sup>TH</sup> CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

- **Section 1:** Middle Tennessee State University will install electronic signs on campus grounds to eliminate the need for outdated yard signs.
- **Section 2:** These electronic signs are to be placed in five locations:
  - Directly outside the Student Union near the amphitheaters,
  - Between the College of Education and the Mass Communication Buildings
  - Between the Keathley University and the KUC Knoll
  - Between Tucker Theatre and Forrest Hall
  - Between Peck Hall and Cope Admin. Building
- **Section 3:** Each department pays a flat rate at the beginning of the semester to advertise for the respective department's events.
- **Section 4:** Outside vendors and businesses will be allowed to advertise on these signs for an allotted amount of time with a given advertisement rate.
- **Section 5:** In emergency situations, (tornado, reported crime, etc) the signs will automatically inform people on campus grounds rather than the usual advertisements.

- **Section 6:** The revenue brought forth by these signs will be inserted into a "printing fund" at Middle Tennessee State University, so as to offset the cost of printing.
- **Section 7:** If passed, this will take effect no later than Fall 2014.
