A Resolution to Allow Student Organizations to Bring Food to Campus

Whereas: Middle Tennessee State University has more than 300 student organizations available

to the student body.

Whereas: Student Organizations are already under significant financial strains without any

excess burdens placed on them by university policies.

Whereas: It is unreasonable to ask official student organizations to purchase food from Aramark

at significantly higher costs to the organizations every time they wish to provide

snacks or refreshments at official organization meetings.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 79th CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

Section 1: All University recognized student organizations shall be allowed to bring up to \$50 of their own food and drinks to use at their official organization meetings as they see fit, providing none of the food or drink violates any campus policy.

Section 2: In order to bring food into a meeting, the only notification necessary is to inform the Center for Student Involvement and Leadership on the use of facilities application in the "event description" area when applying for the use of the room. **Section 3:** No organization shall be denied use of facilities for requesting to bring their own snacks and refreshments to an official organization meeting.
