Whereas: There are a limited number of Red and Green Parking spaces

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 78TH CONGRESS OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCATION OF MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

Section 1: Parking Regulations section 3-2, subsection (b) and (d) are suspended during a State of Emergency in the state of Tennessee if the MTSU parking garages are deemed hazardous to student safety.

Section 2: Until hazards within the parking garages are properly disposed, Students holding a Green Permit are allowed to park in Red spaces to ensure student safety.
