A Resolution to Install a Big Belly Solar Trash Compactor at Middle Tennessee State University

Whereas:	Installation of another compactor would benefit the MTSU community by being a visible, environmentally friendly solution to trash overflow;
Whereas:	Big Belly compactors are far more aesthetic than the traditional outdoor trash bin;
Whereas:	Installation of another compactor would reduce Custodial Services workload, while decreasing the volume of waste entering the Middle Point Landfill;
